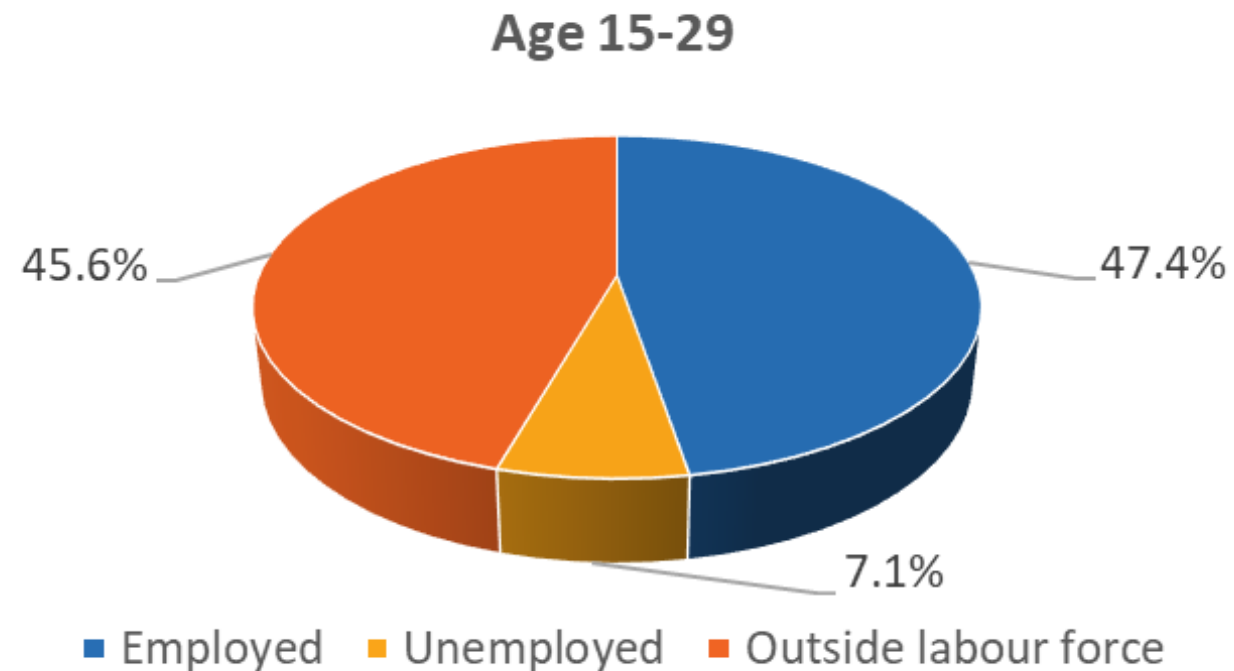
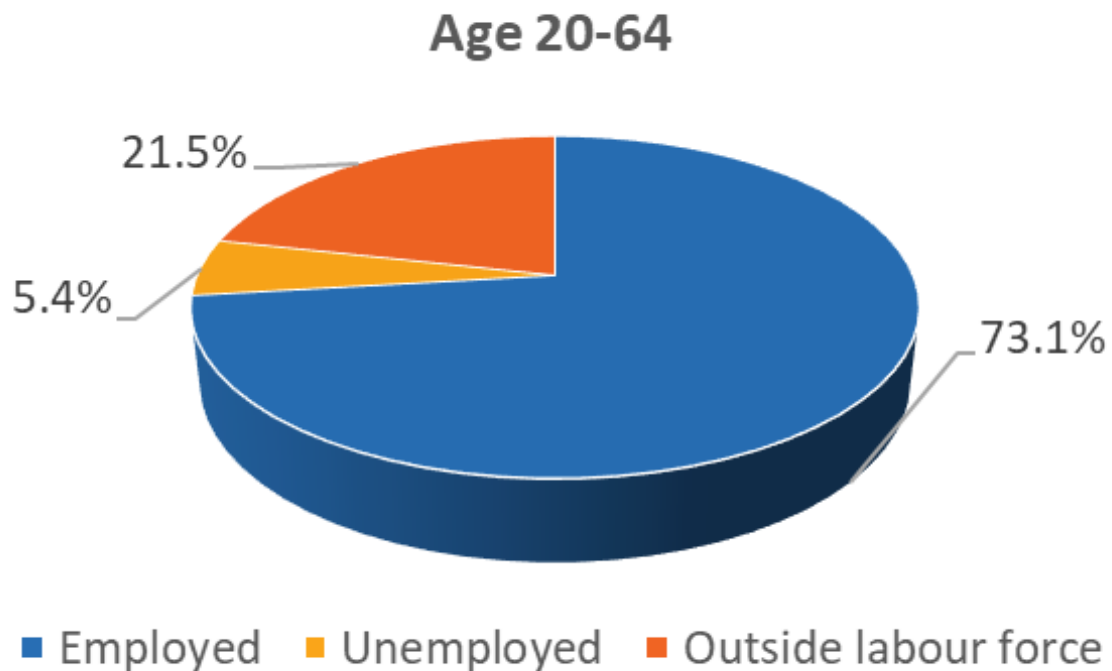

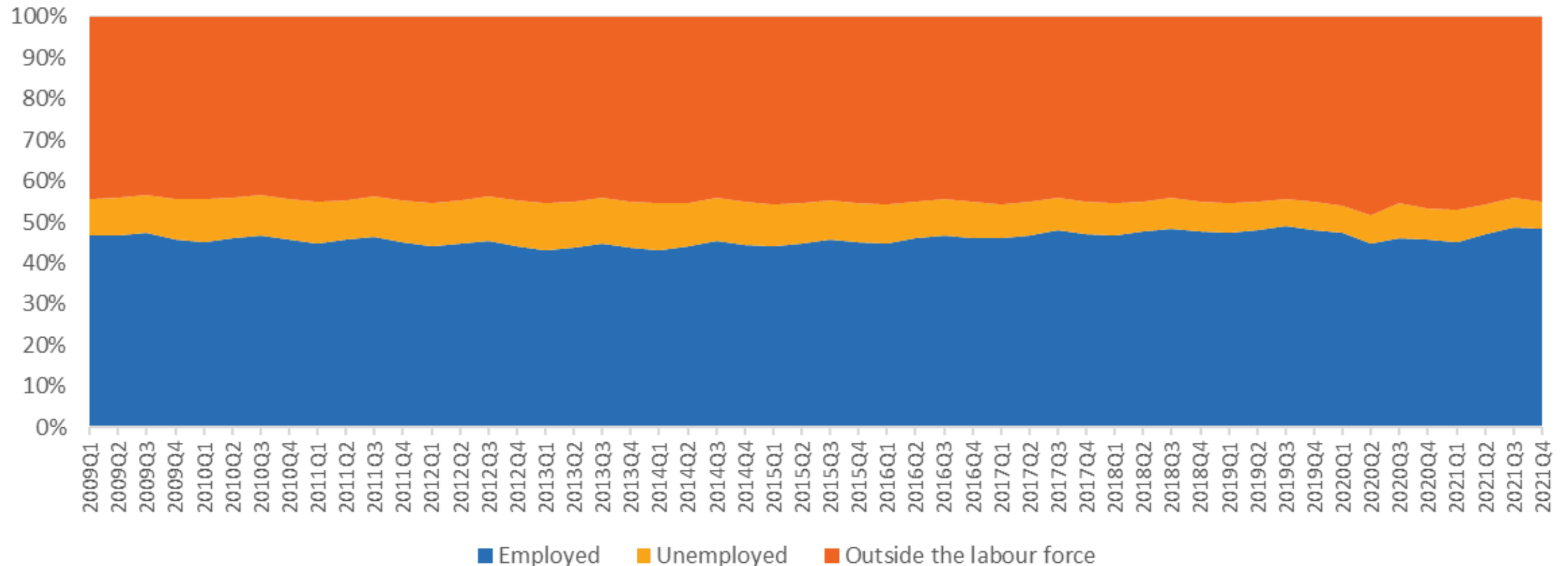

EU level, 2021 data

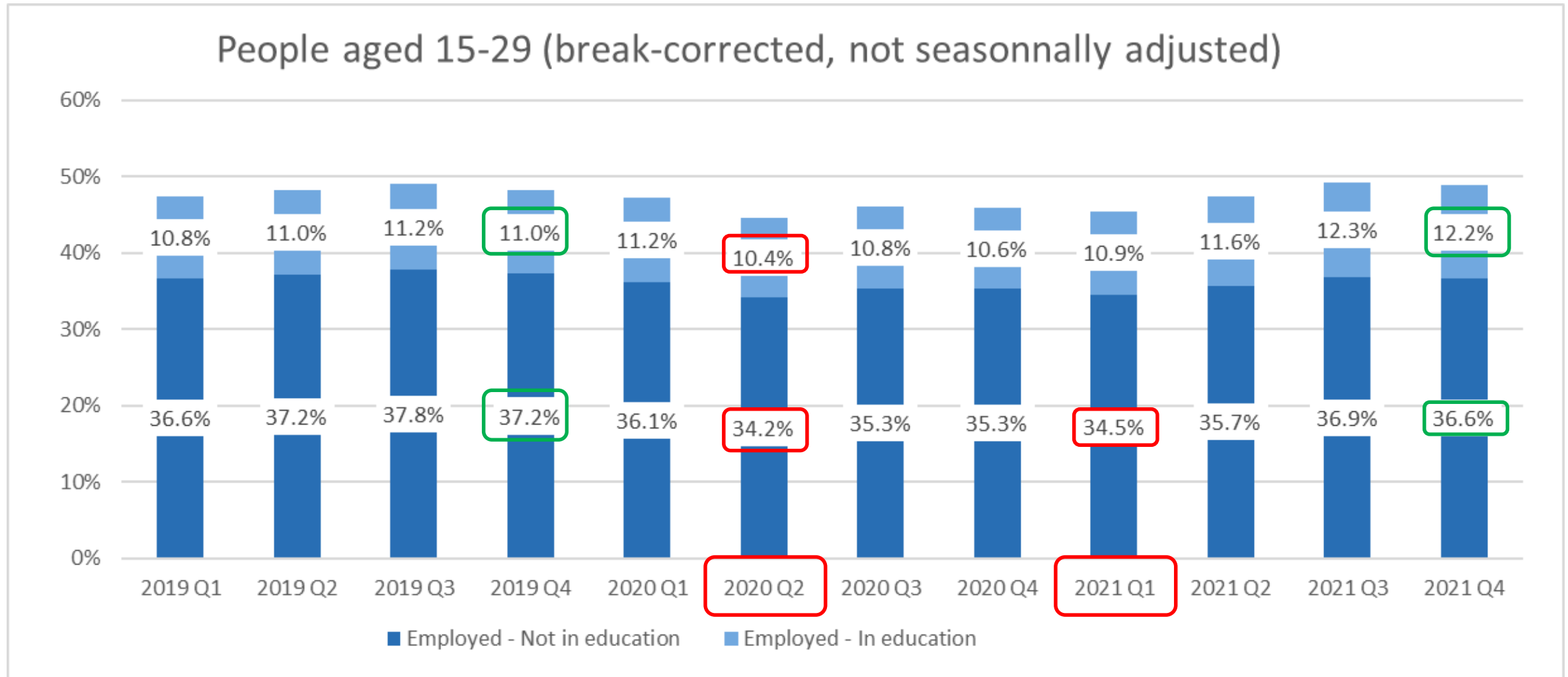


# How did it evolve in the last decade ?

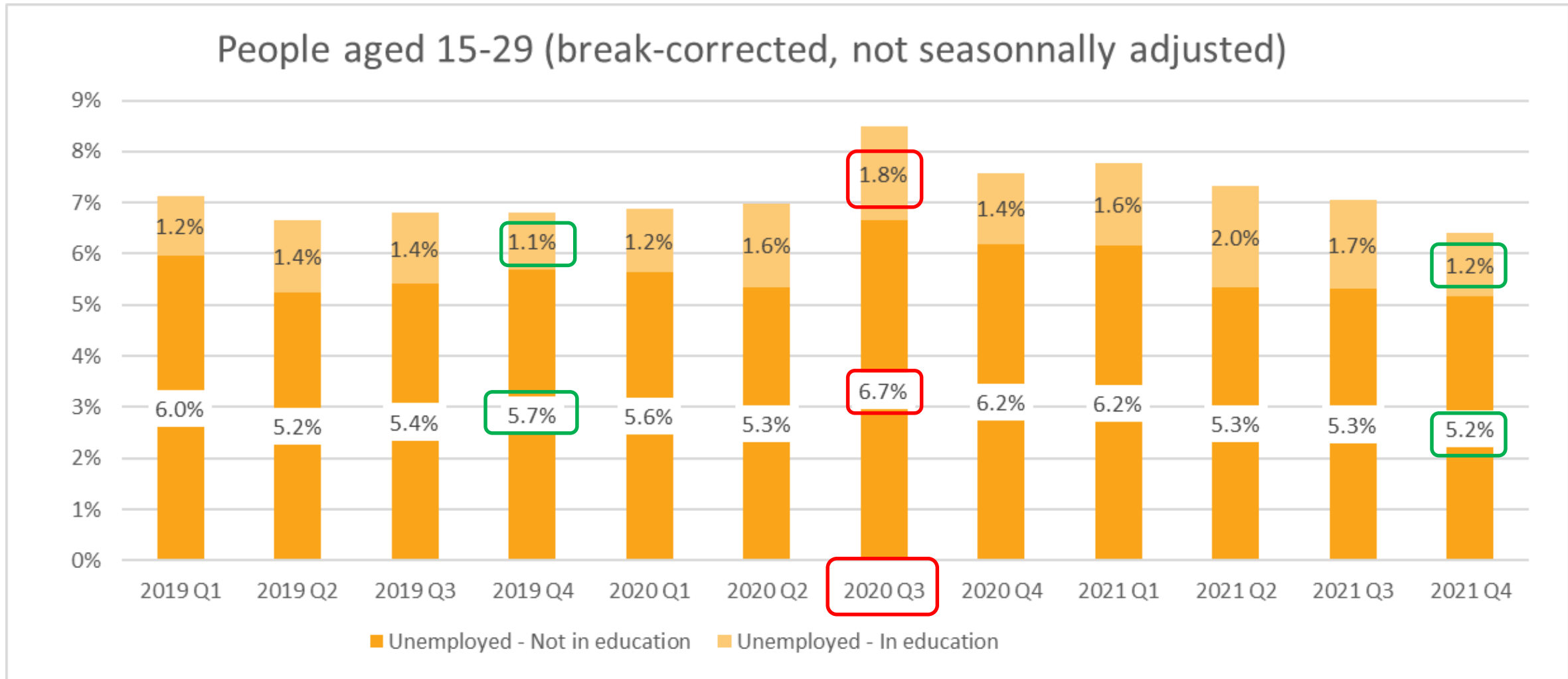
People aged 15-29 (break-corrected, not seasonally adjusted)



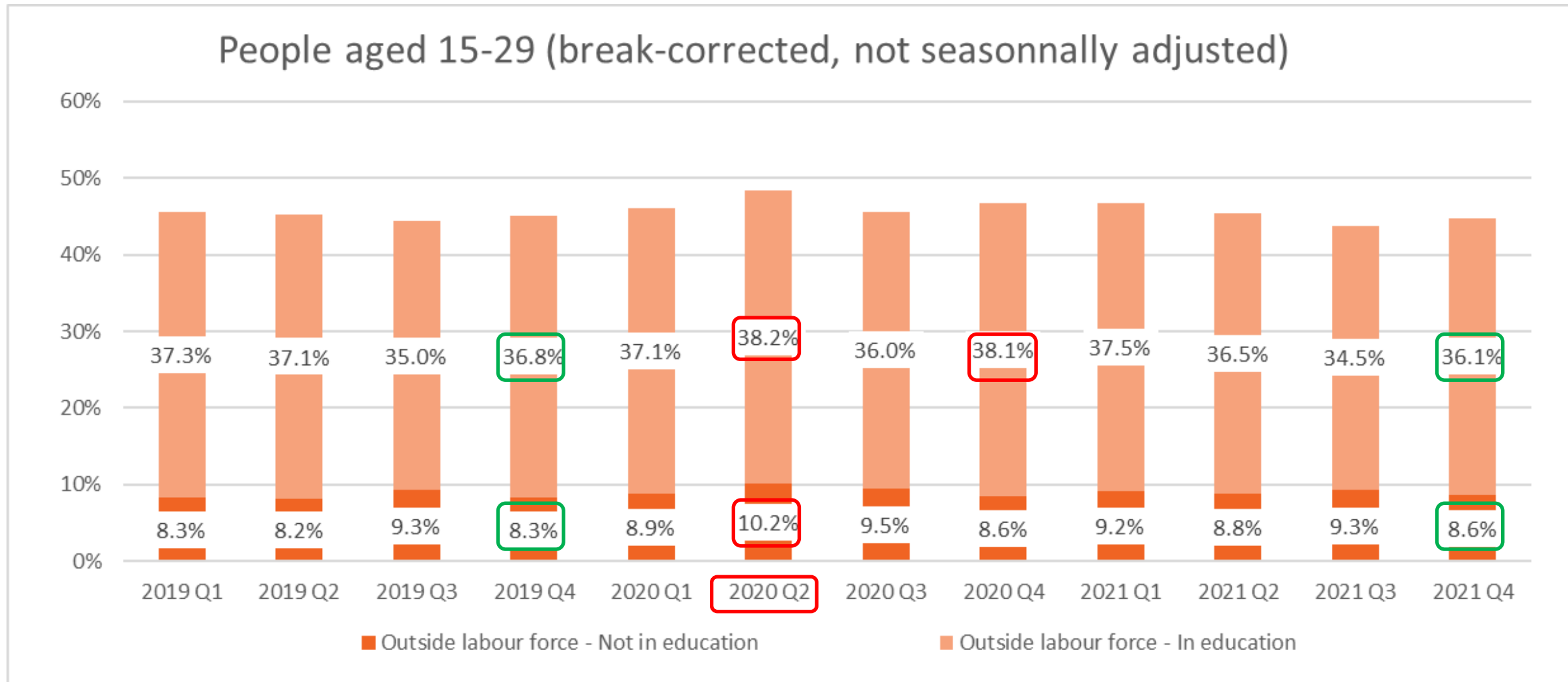
# Which impact did COVID-19 have on youth employment ?



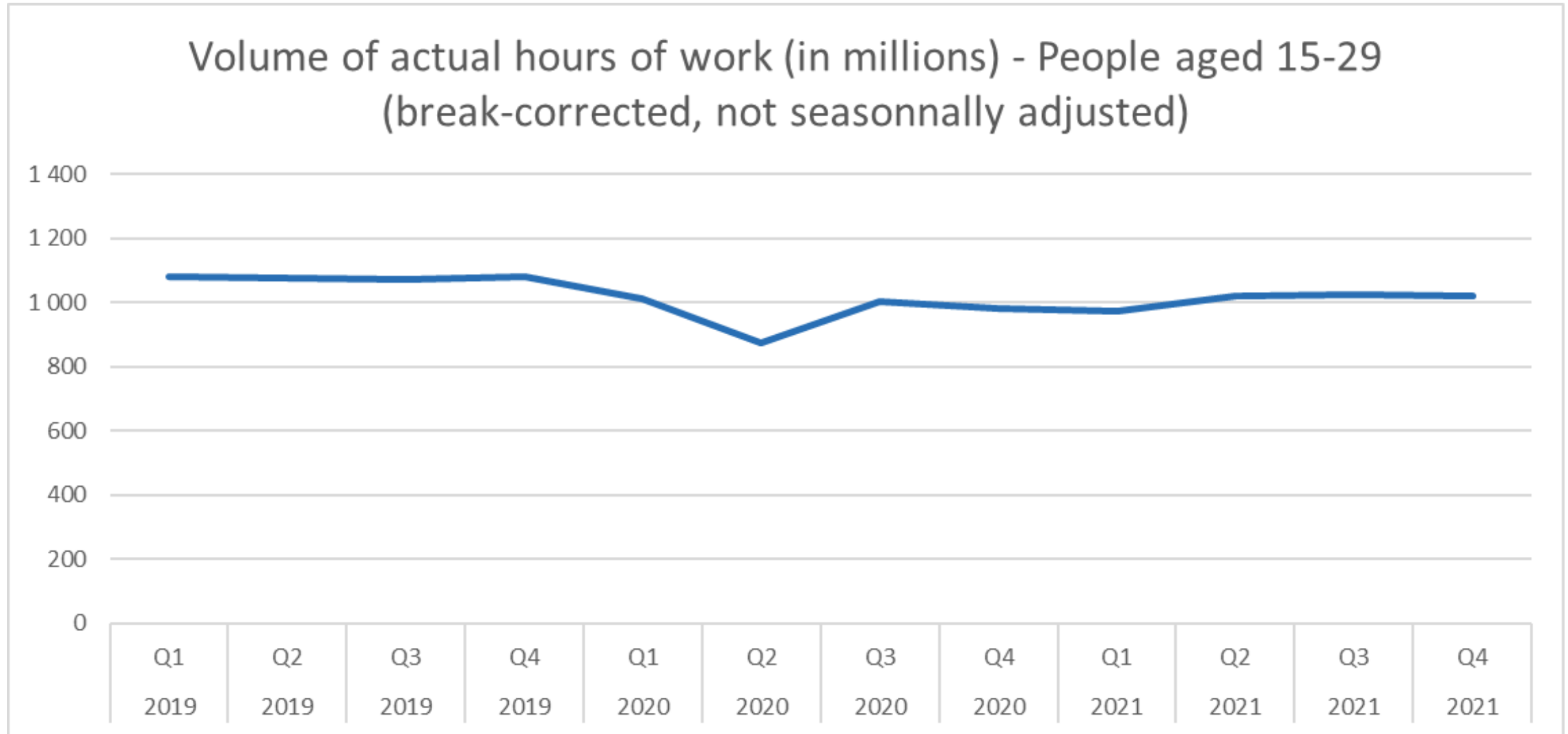
# Which impact did COVID-19 have on youth unemployment ?



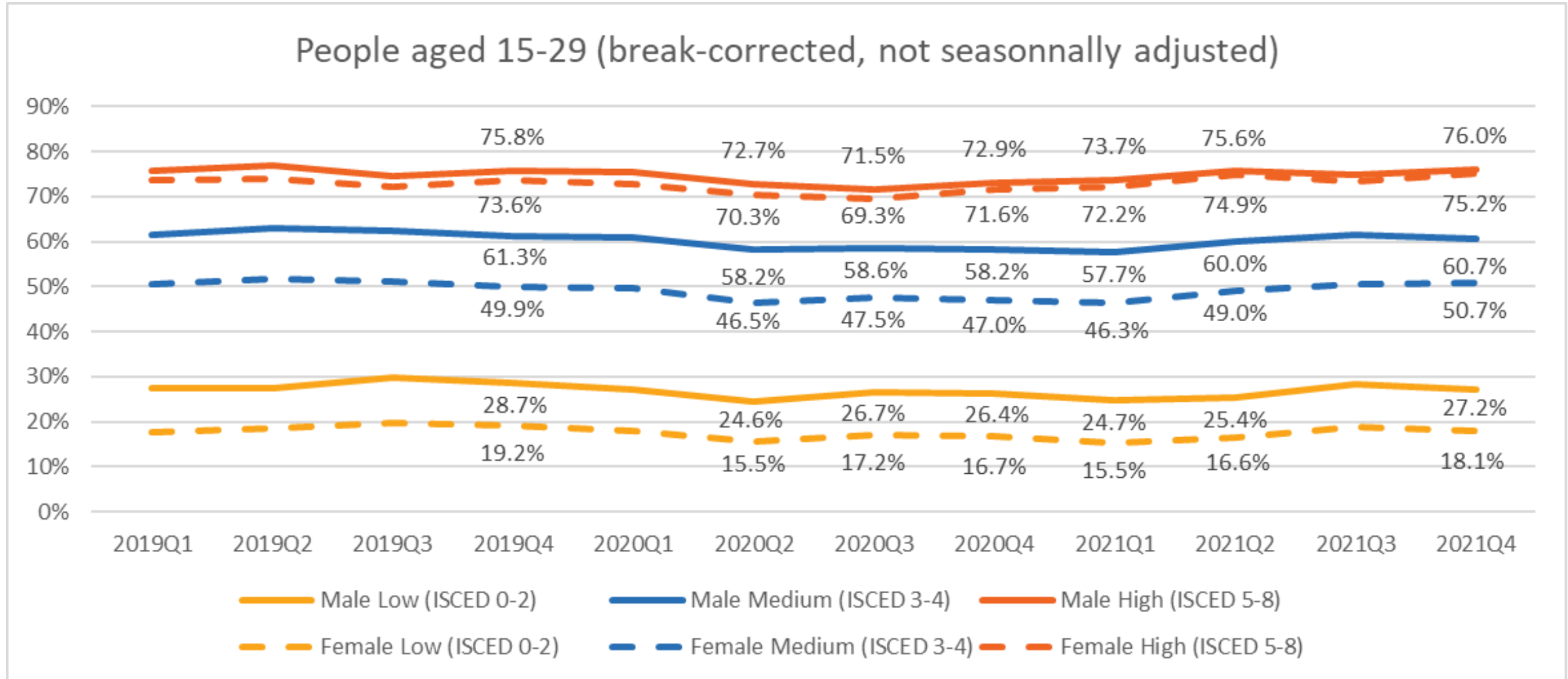
# Which impact did COVID-19 have on young people outside the labour force?



# Which impact did COVID-19 have on the hours of work for young people?

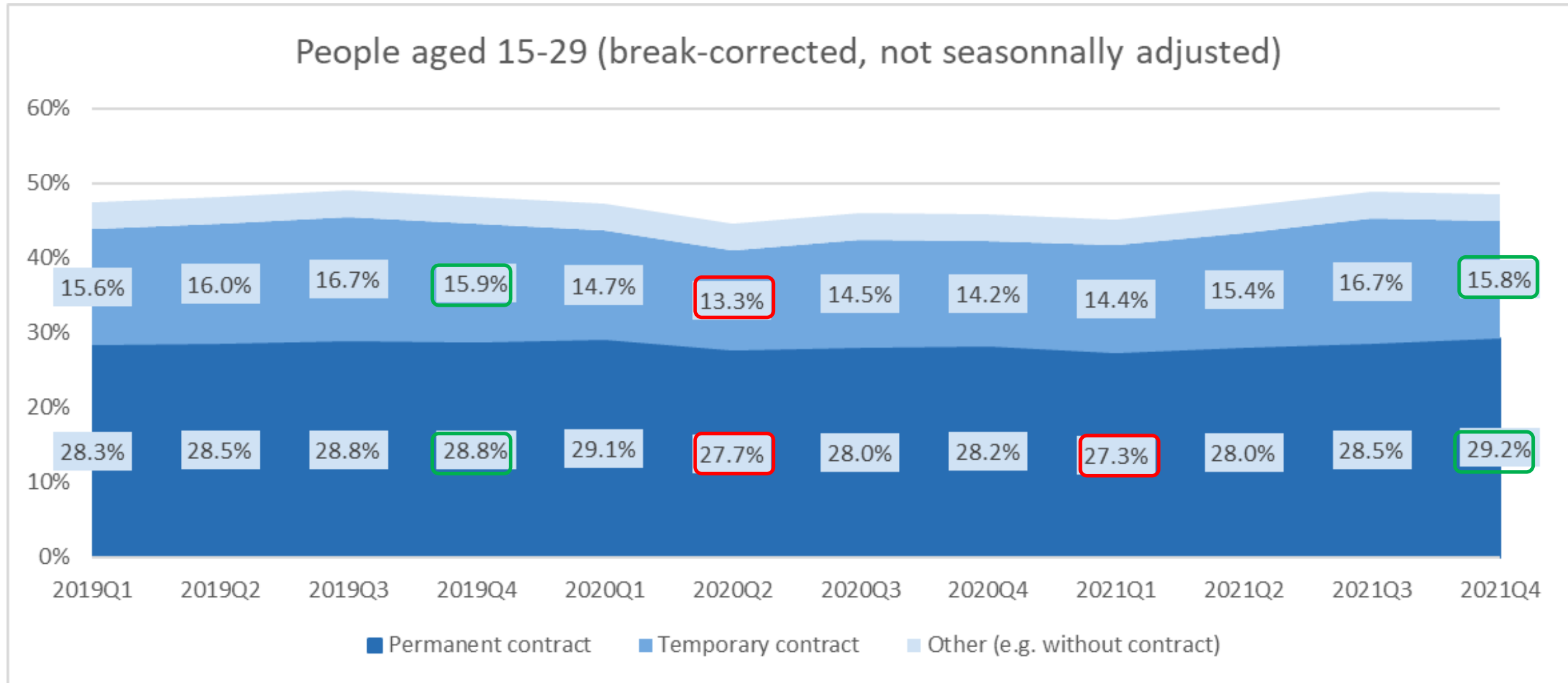


# Youth employment by sex and educational attainment level



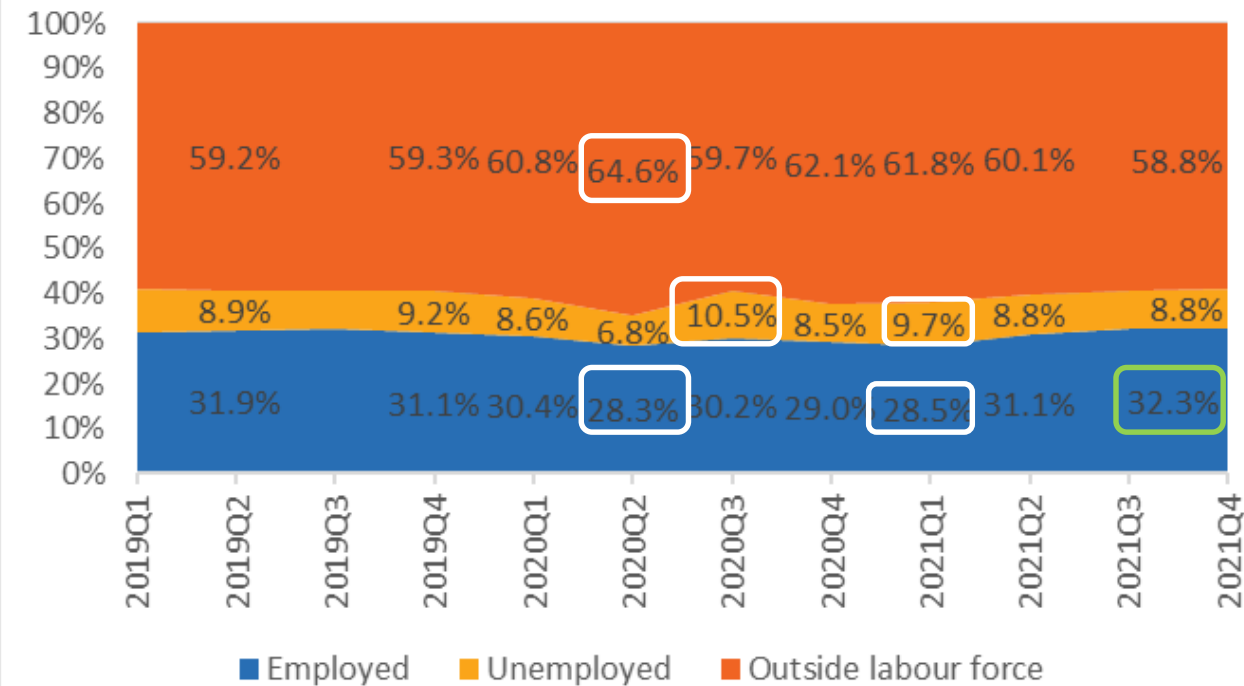


# Youth employment by type of contract (permanent / temporary)

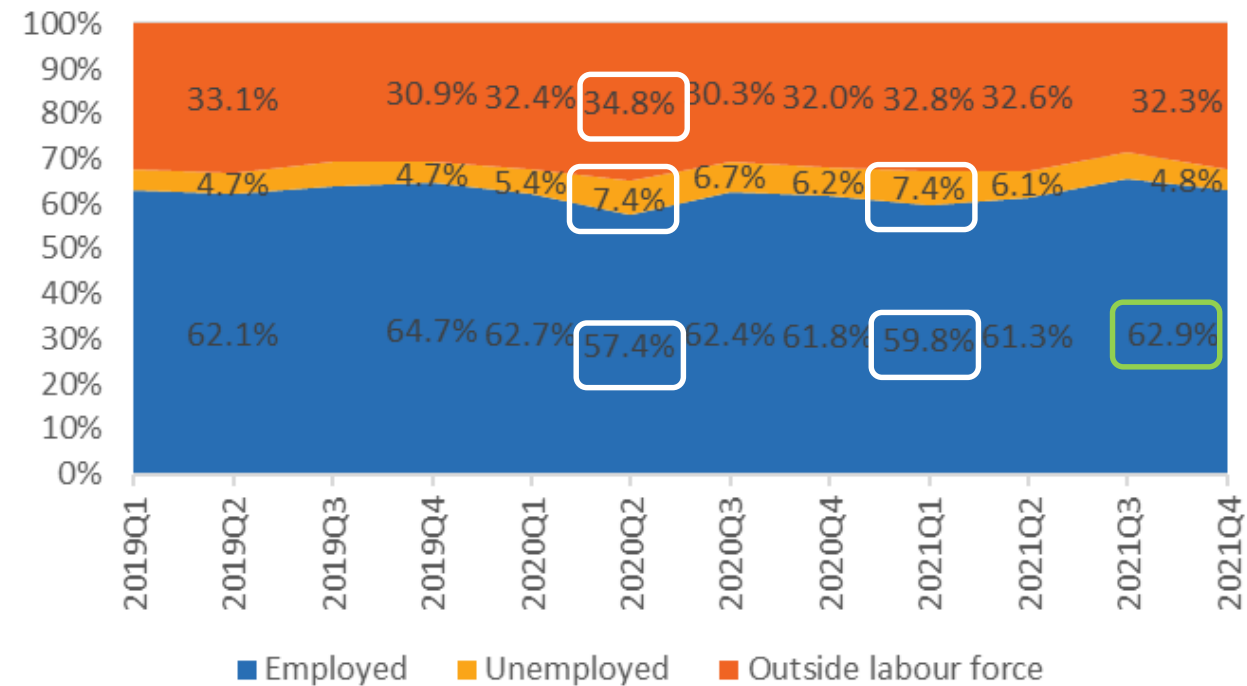

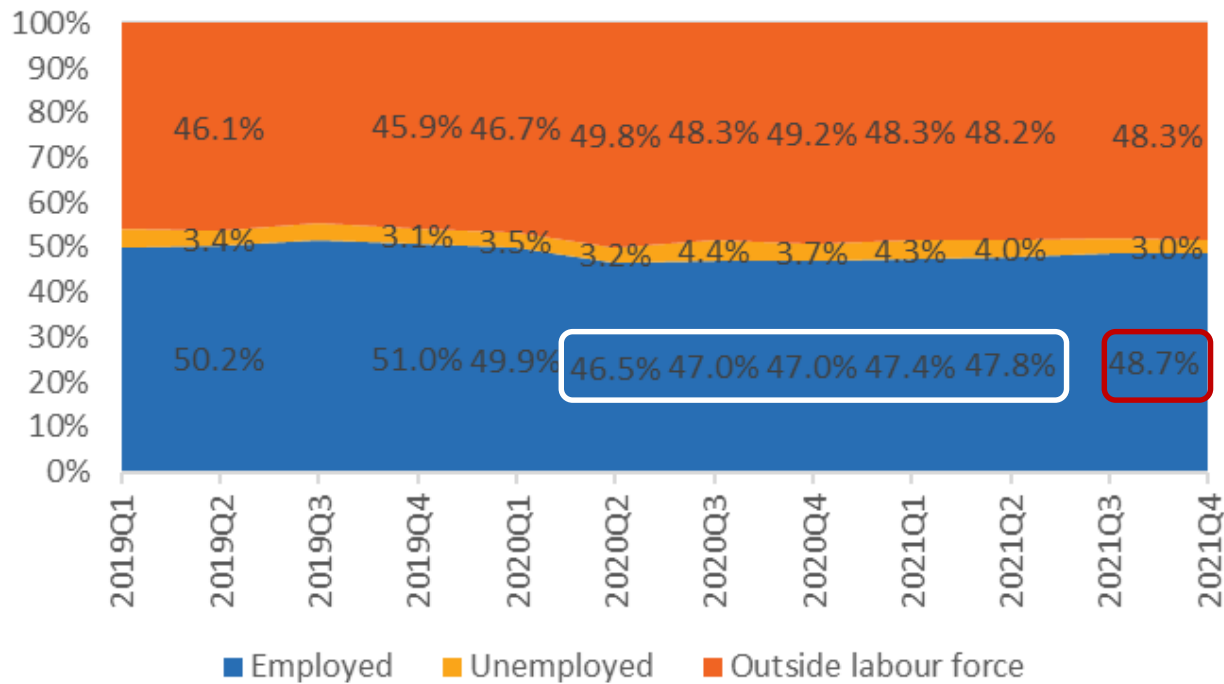

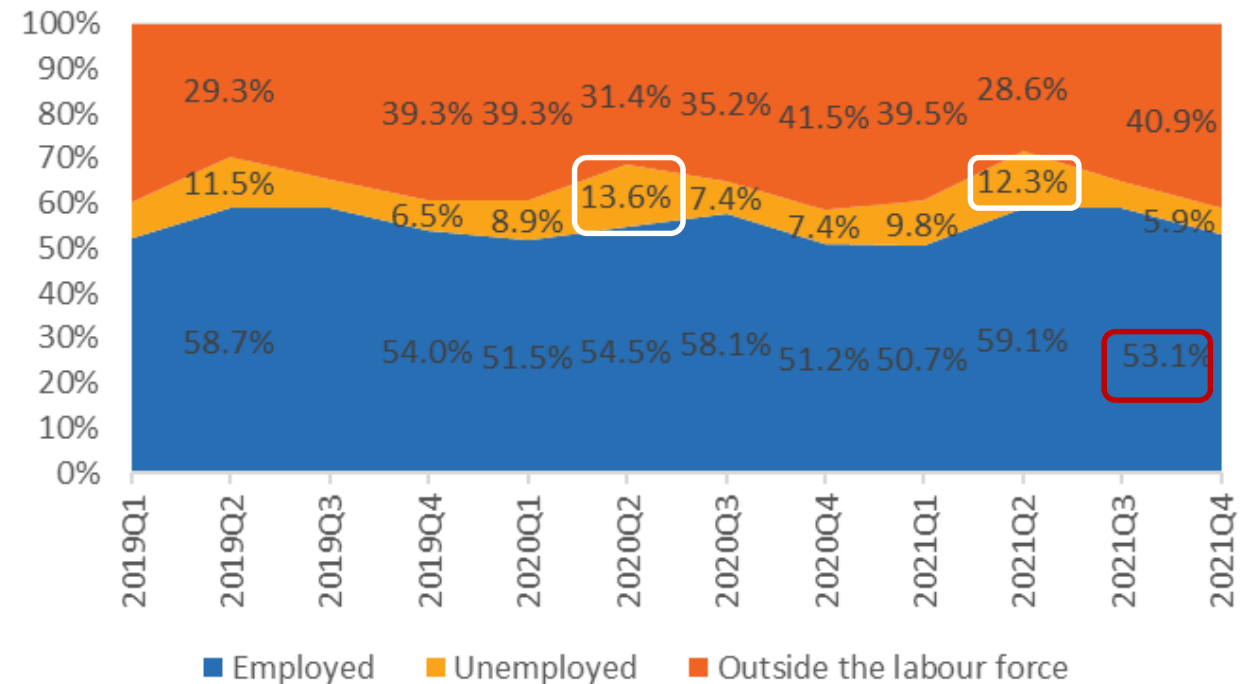

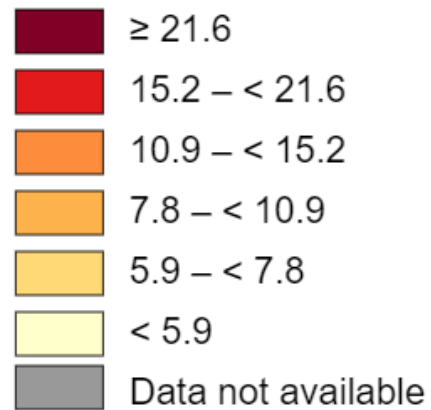

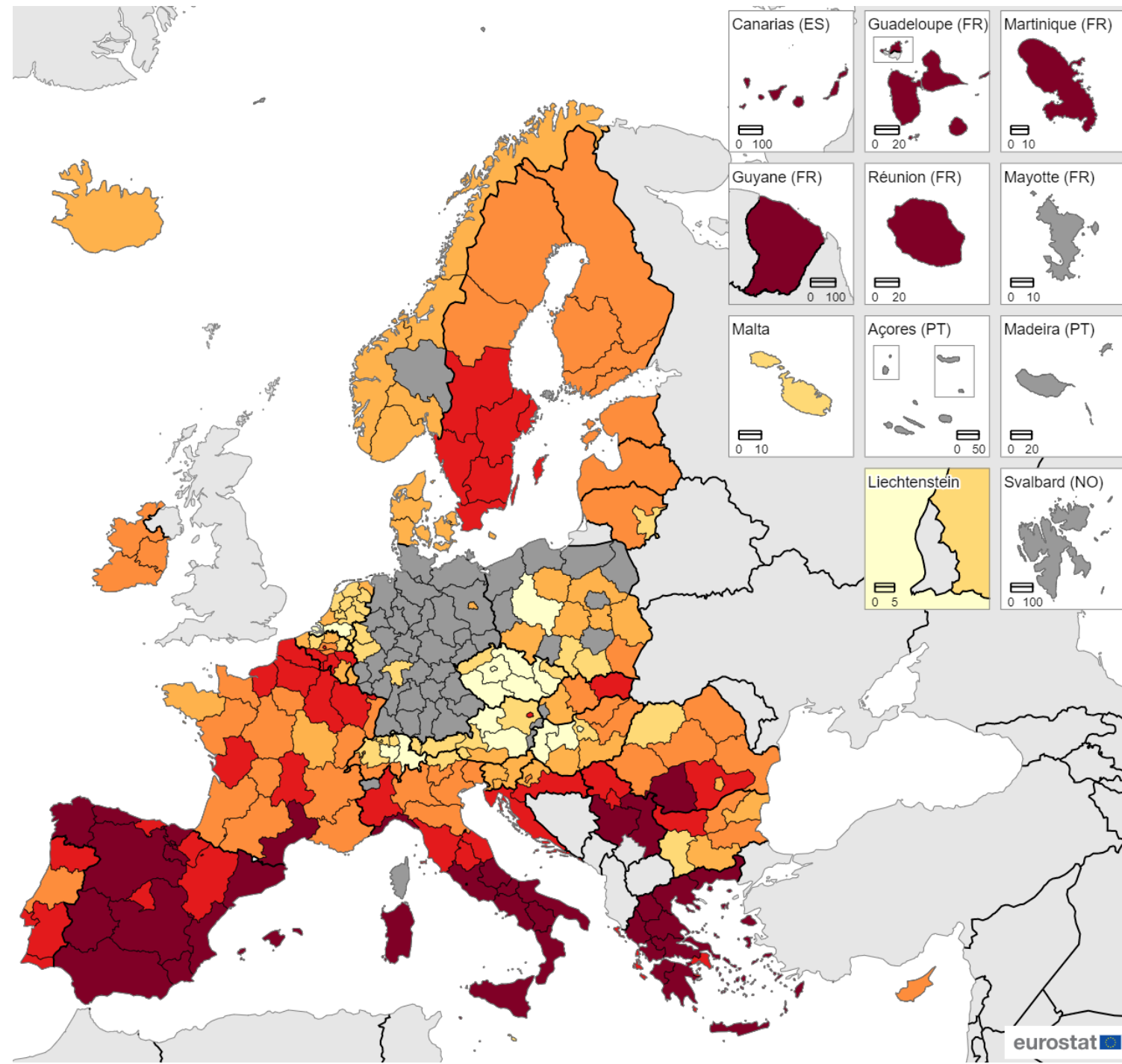
