




EU level, 2021 data













Which impact did COVID-19 have on youth unemployment?






Which impact did COVID-19 have on the hours of work for young people?




Youth employment by sex and educational attainment level




Youth employment by type of contract (permanent / temporary)












Is the situation similar in the different EU Member States? (2/2)








Unemployment rate by region in 2021, for people aged 15-29




